Sarawak Youth Talent (SYT2021) is co-organized by Sarawak Research Society and the Faculty of Hospitality and Tourism Management, UCSI University with the support of the Ministry of tourism, Arts and Culture Sarawak and Jabatan Pendidikan Negeri Sarawak. It consists of two contests: (1) A4-sized poster for secondary school students and (2) one-minute videography for college/university students in Sarawak. Each contestant must submit a completed registration form together with his/her production. Submission should be done online by 20th July 2021.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Information

Sarawak Youth Talent (SYT2021) is co-organized by Sarawak Research Society and the Faculty of Hospitality and Tourism Management, UCSI University with the support of the Ministry of tourism, Arts and Culture Sarawak and Jabatan Pendidikan Negeri Sarawak in accordance with the following Terms and Conditions, which can also be found at our website at www.sarawakresearchsociety.org/syt2021. You can also visit our Facebook page titled [Sarawak Youth Talent](#).

All productions must be related to the theme of SYT2021, namely “**Responsible Behaviour towards Tourism, Arts and Culture in Sarawak**”. Contestants can choose any theme related to the responsible behaviour towards tourism, arts or culture in Sarawak. Contestants who wish to participate in the contest are required to complete and submit their registration form together with their production directly to us at sarawakyouthtalent@gmail.com by **20th July 2021**. Damaged, incomplete, inappropriate (such as controversial content) or illegible productions will not be accepted. Evaluation of all the productions will be done online **from 24th July to 6th August 2021** by the judges, contestants and the public. The award-giving ceremony using a hybrid format will be held at **UCSI Hotel Kuching on 14th August 2021** where the winners will be announced. Contestants are required to join the ceremony online and the platform details will be given to the contestants in advance. The ceremony will also be livestreamed on Facebook.

The Organizer may at its sole and absolute discretion extend SYT2021 period at any time. The Organizer also reserves the right to modify the event mechanisms, withdraw or cancel the event at any time at its sole and absolute direction.

Eligibility

The contest is open only to students who reside in Sarawak: Secondary school students for poster contest and University/College students for videography contest. Each registration is only good for one person.

Submission Guidelines

Poster Guidelines

- The content must be related to the theme of SYT2021.
- Poster must be prepared in the digital form with the size of A4 paper (297x210 mm).
- The content must be written in English (except for specific terms).
- Poster must clearly show: (1) specific aspect(s) of responsible behaviour or action, and (2) the selected theme (tourism, arts or culture). The descriptions of tourism, arts and culture are provided on our website.
- Poster should deliver a meaningful message (using images and words) in accordance with its theme.
- The production in PDF or image file (JPEG or PNG) must be submitted to sarawakyouthtalent@gmail.com. The content will be reviewed before sending for evaluation.

One-Minute Videography Guidelines

- The content must be related to the theme of SYT2021.
- Video must not exceed 1 minute. Narration must be in English. BM or Mandarin is allowed if subtitles in English are provided.
- Video must clearly show: (1) specific aspect(s) of responsible behaviour or action, and (2) the selected theme (tourism, arts or culture). The descriptions of tourism, arts and culture are provided on our website.
- Video should deliver a meaningful message (using images and words) in accordance with its theme.
- The production in MP4 in good quality (at least 1920x1080 px) should be submitted to sarawakyouthtalent@gmail.com. The content will be reviewed before sending for evaluation.

Specific Information

- Every contestant must provide valid information on the registration form. Incomplete form will not be considered.
- Every submission must be done by individual. Registration by groups is not accepted.
- All submitted productions must be the original works of the contestants, and no part or component thereof is copied from any other works.
- By submitting a production to SYT2021, each contestant confirms that he/she is the legal and/or beneficial owner or otherwise has the intellectual property rights to submit such production; and therefore, warrant that he/she has obtained rights in incorporating copyright materials i.e. music, soundtrack, audio, images and video clips in his/her production. Each production and any part thereof shall not at any time infringe or violate any laws or the rights of third party.
- Submitted productions must not have been submitted to or contested in any other contests or events before.
- Submitted productions must not contain or reference any names or products of any company or any third-party trademarks, logos, or recognizable figures without formal consent
- Inappropriate productions that are lewd, obscene, sexually explicit, pornographic, disparaging, defamatory, libelous, illegal, offensive, or otherwise contain controversial content or objectionable material should not be submitted. The Organizer reserves the right to remove or demand the contestant to remove/revise such content at any time at Organizer’s sole discretion.
- By submitting the productions, the contestants have granted the Organizer exclusive rights to use them for promotional purpose whenever appropriate and necessary.
- All costs and any expenses in connection with the productions shall be fully borne by the contestants.
- All productions will be judged mainly based on **(A) Relevance to the Theme; (B) Originality and Creativity; and (C) Delivery of Message**. Although poster-designing and video-making skills are important, they are secondary. All productions will be reviewed from 24th July to 6th August 2021. Judges’ decision is final, conclusive and binding. No further appeal, enquiry and/or correspondence will be entertained.
- Every contestant will receive e-Certificate of Participation. Certificate of Recognition will be given to individuals who win the contest.
- Contestants are not required to attend the award-giving ceremony physically on 14th August 2021 as they can join the ceremony online.

Prizes and Recognitions

Poster Contest

- RM300 (Top 5 productions)
- RM100 (5 Recommended Productions)

Other prizes in non-monetary form will also be given to the winners as well as the contestants and participants (supporters, teachers and family members) during the ceremony.

One-Minute Videography Contest

- RM400 (Top 5 productions)
- RM150 (5 Recommended Productions)

Judging Panel and Procedure

- All productions will go through preliminary review after submission. The approved posters and videos will then be uploaded on Sarawak Youth Talent Facebook page for viewing and voting by the judges, contestants and the public. Top 5 posters and videos will be shown during the award-giving ceremony on 14th August 2021.
- Judging panel includes government officials, academics and practitioners in the tourism, arts and culture sectors will contribute **70%** of the total scores. The votes from the contestants will make up **20%**, and the votes from the public based on the number of likes on each production on [Sarawak Youth Talent](#) Facebook page **from 24th July to 6th August 2021** which make up the remaining **10%**.
